ORDINANCE NO. 4430

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Parkwood Campus to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Parkwood Campus to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective June 28, 1979.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 79-681, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 8, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 6th day of August, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Parkwood Campus and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Parkwood Campus to be annexed is described as follows:

Those portions of Section 8, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington described as follows:






