

ORDINANCE NO. 0004452

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of 236th Place NE
(Woodinville-Duvall Road to NE 180th Street) and NE 180th
Street (236th Place NE to 244th Avenue NE)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transporta-
tion has made an examination of 236th Place NE and NE 180th Street along the
course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon
the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width,
having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of the Woodinville-Duvall Road
at its intersection with the centerline of 236th Place NE, said point
being S 2°22'50" E 2,208.42 feet of the North 1/4 corner of Section 10,
Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington; thence
N 27°30'00" E 251.22 feet; thence along a tangent curve to the left
having a radius of 300 feet through a central angle of 24°30'30" an arc
distance of 128.28 feet; thence N 3°00'00" E 7.42 feet; thence along a
tangent curve to the right having a radius of 300 feet through a central
angle of 53°57'59" an arc distance of 282.57 feet; thence N 56°57'59" E
176.02 feet; thence along a tangent curve to the left having a radius
of 1,500 feet through a central angle of 5°25'22" an arc distance of
141.97 feet; thence N 51°32'37" E 72.68 feet; thence along a tangent
curve to the right having a radius of 325 feet through a central angle of
39°21'54" an arc distance of 223.29 feet; thence S 89°05'29" E 1,661.09
feet to a terminus on the east line of said Section 10, said terminus
being N 3°34'10" E 1,284.85 feet from the East 1/4 corner of said
Section 10, said terminus also being centerline of 244th Avenue NE,
Engineers Station 29+41.62.

2,944.54 Feet = .558 Mile

1 SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said
2 roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
