ORDINANCE NO. _0004477

AN ORDINANCE establishing an Emergency Medical Services Fund providing for the receipt and disbursement of emergency medical services revenues; and making an appropriation of \$440,680 therefrom for expenses of funding Emergency Medical Services for the fourth quarter of fiscal year 1979; and amending Ordinance No. 3969 by adding a new section; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> There is hereby created an Emergency Medical Services Fund.

SECTION 2. The Emergency Medical Services Fund shall be used for the deposit of all emergency medical services levy revenues, intragovernmental transfers, and contributions, and for the disbursement of Emergency Medical Services program costs.

SECTION 3. \$440,680 is hereby appropriated from a Current Expense Fund loan to Emergency Medical Services for the payment of paramedic provider group contract expenses and other Emergency Medical Services operating costs. The County Executive is authorized to enter into contracts and agreements as required to implement Emergency Medical Services through December 31, 1979.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 3969, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
