

ORDINANCE No. 0004495

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water District 104 Comprehensive Sewerage Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On June 4, 1979, Water District 104 passed Resolution No. 960 adopting the Comprehensive Sewerage Plan 1979.

Water District 104 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan on June 4, 1979.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan and on August 22, 1979 recommended its conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 104 Comprehensive Sewerage Plan 1979 as adopted by district Resolution No. 960 (attached) is hereby approved provided:

a. This approval is limited to those areas of Water District 104 which are designated Local Service Area by the Sewerage General Plan, and

b. The proposed 15" sewer trunk within subbasin SAM-3A is not approved, and

c. The facilities shown in subbasins SAM-2 and SAM-1 for service to the development known as Sunrise shall not be approved, until the finalization of the interlocal agreement between the parties concerned, and

d. Any subsequent amendments or additions and betterments to the Water District 104 Comprehensive Sewerage Plan 1979 shall:

(1) be considered by King County consistent with the provisions of KCC 13.24, and

(2) include a clear graphic representation of how the proposed amendment relates to the existing Water District
