ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE conditionally approving the Wax Road Amendment to the Water District 108 Comprehensive Plan for water supply system.

PREAMBLE:

Water District 108 adopted Resolution No. 1387 on May 23, 1979, providing for additions and betterments along SE Wax Road.

Water District 108 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed additions and betterments on May 17, 1979.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed additions and betterments as required by KCC 13.24 and Ordinance No. 4146, and on Sept. 12, 1979 recommended their conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Wax Road additions and betterments to the Water District 198 Comprehensive Plan for water supply system as adopted by district Resolution No. 1387 (attached) are hereby approved, PROVIDED THAT:

1. This approval shall not be taken as County endorsement of future changes to more intensive land use zones. Approval of a rezone(s) in the proposed service area on S.E. Wax Road shall be made on the basis of recommendations based on County land use plans and policies, and

2. Fire hydrants shall be installed consistent with KCC 17.08.040.

The report and recommendation of the Utilities Technical Review Committee (attached) is hereby incorporated by reference.
