## 22. SPECIAL LATECOMER CHARGE STIPULATION

In addition to the fees stated herein, there will be a fixed lat ecomer charge payable to the District. The charge will be a pro rata share of the total cost of the Burlington Northern Railroad and State Highway crossings installed under DE S-79-2.
