ORDINANCE NO.

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AN ORDINANCE relating to the enforcement of violations of land use and public health ordinances; establishing new civil penalty rates, repealing Ordinance 2909, Section 106, and KCC 23.08.090 and adding new sections to KCC 23.08.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2909, Section 106 and KCC 23.08.090 are each hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. A new section is added to KCC 23.08 to read as follows:

CIVIL PENALTIES - PROCEDURES (a) Any person or organization who violates any land use or public health ordinance, or rules and regulations adopted thereunder, or the conditions of any permit issued pursuant to such ordinance, rule or regulation, or who by any act of commission or omission procures, aids or abets such violation shall be subject to civil penalties as provided in this chapter.

- (b) Civil penalties may be directly assessed by the appropriate director by means of a notice and order issued pursuant to KCC 23.12 or may be recovered by legal action filed in King County Superior Court by the Prosecuting Attorney on behalf of King County.
- Civil penalties assessed by means of a notice and order shall be collected in accordance with the lien, personal obligation, and other procedures specified in this title. penalties assessed in a legal action in Superior Court shall be collected in the same manner as judgments in civil actions.

SECTION 3. A new section is added to KCC 23.08 to read as follows:

CIVIL PENALTIES - GENERAL REQUIREMENTS (a) Any person engaged in the development, management, sale, rental or use of property solely for the purpose of residential occupancy by said person or his or her immediate family shall be deemed to be

engaged in noncommercial ventures for purposes of this chapter.

All other persons shall be deemed to be engaged in commercial ventures for purposes of this chapter.

(b) Each and every day or portion thereof during which any violation is committed, continued, permitted or not corrected shall be deemed a violation for purposes of this title. Civil penalties for failure to obtain any required permit shall begin to accrue on the first day activity subject to the permit requirement is commenced and shall cease to accrue on the day the permit is obtained. Civil penalties for violation of any stop work order shall begin to accrue on the first day the stop work order is posted and shall cease on the day the work is actually stopped.

SECTION 4. A new section is added to KCC 23.08 to read as follows:

CIVIL PENALTIES - SCHEDULES (a) Civil penalties for violations of persons engaged in commercial ventures shall be assessed pursuant to the following schedule:

Violation of KCC ch. 8.12 - \$1000 per violation

Violation of KCC ch. 8.60 - \$ 500 per violation

Violation of KCC Title 10 - \$ 250 per violation

Violation of KCC 12.92 - \$ 500 per violation

Violation of KCC Title 13 - \$ 250 per violation

Violation of KCC ch. 16.82 - \$ 500 per violation

Violation of KCC Title 19 - \$ 250 per violation

Violation of KCC Title 19 - \$ 250 per violation

Violation of any stop

work order - \$ 500 per violation

All other violations - \$ 150 per violation

(b) Civil penalties for violations by persons engaged in noncommercial ventures shall be assessed pursuant to the following schedule:

Violation of KCC ch. 8.12 - \$ 500 per violation Violation of KCC ch. 8.60 - \$ 250 per violation
