ORDINANCE NO. 4577

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, establishing a passenger curb loading zone on the north side of Southwest 154th Street in the vicinity of 6th Avenue SW, and amending King County Ordinance 1100, Schedule 19.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by KCC 46.61.575-4 adopting RCW 46.61.575, Schedule 19 of the King County Traffic Code which establishes passenger curb loading zones along county roads is amended to add the following location:

SOUTHWEST 154TH STREET, on the north side beginning at a point 200 feet easterly of the centerline of 6th Avenue Southwest to a point 50 feet east of the centerline of 6th Avenue Southwest.

SECTION 2. Signs posted to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.
