

REPEALED BY ORDINANCE 4672

ORDINANCE NO. 4596

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of  
S.E. 41st Street and declaring an emergency.  
(124th Ave. SE to 128th Ave. SE)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and  
Transportation has made an examination of SE 41st Street along the  
course and description set forth below and has made a favorable  
report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than  
60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width on each side of the  
following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of 124th Ave. SE  
and SE 41st Street, said point being 1024.63 feet  
southerly of the quarter corner of Sec. 9 and 16,  
Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County,  
Washington, THENCE in an easterly direction a  
distance of 1233.82 feet to a point of terminus  
on the centerline of 128th Ave. SE.  
1233.82 feet = 0.234 mile.

SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment  
of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a  
public necessity.

SECTION 4: The County Council finds as a fact and declares  
that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for  
the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for  
the support of county government and its existing public  
institutions.
