ORDINANCE NO. 4604

AN ORDINANCE establishing processing fees for the King County Department of Public Works Hydraulics Division's role in approving drainage plans for land development and building permits; and establishing the method of payment for these fees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The fees for processing land development and building permit related drainage plans through, and/or receiving Department of Public Works, Hydraulics Division approval shall be as follows:

Commercial Building Permit	\$250
Short Sub-Division	\$500
Regular Sub-Division	\$750

SECTION 2. A separate fee will be assessed for each time a drainage plan is returned to the applicant for revision due to applicant error. The resubmission fee schedule shall be as follows:

1st Resubmittal	\$ 0
2nd Resubmittal	\$300
3rd Resubmittal	\$300
4th Resubmittal and following resubmittals	\$200

SECTION 3. Commercial Building Permits which require Hydraulics Division review of drainage plans as mandated under the provisions of K.C.C. 20.50.030 will be assessed \$250 at the time the commercial permit is issued. This \$250 is additional to the regular building permit fee. The Hydraulics Division fee will be credited to the River Improvement Fund.

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1 SECTION 4. Short subdivision permit applications which
 2 require full Hydraulics Division review of drainage plans as
 3 mandated under the provisions of K.C.C. 20.50.030 will be
 4 assessed an additional \$500. Collection of this fee will be
 5 included in the regular short subdivision established and
 6 collected by the County Road Engineer. The Hydraulics Division
 7 fee will be credited to the River Improvement Fund.

8 SECTION 5. Regular subdivision applications which require
 9 full Hydraulics Division review of drainage plans as mandated under
 10 the provision of K.C.C. 20.50.030 will be assessed an additional
 11 \$750. Collection of this fee will be included in the regular
 12 subdivision fee established and collected by the County Road
 13 Engineer. The Hydraulics Division fee will be credited to the
 14 River Improvement Fund.


15 SECTION 6. The effective date of the Hydraulics Division fee
 16 schedule is January 1, 1980.

17 PROVIDED THAT: Fee increases scheduled to be effective January 1,
 18 1980, shall become null and void if Ordinance 4597 is vetoed in
 19 whole, or in part by the Executive.


