

ORDINANCE NO. 4620

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Turner to King County Water District No. 105.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Turner to King County Water District No. 105 was filed with the County Council effective October 15, 1979.

2. King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 697, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 7, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 104W day of December, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Turner and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

2 described as follows:

3 The Southeast 1/4 of Section 26, Township 22 North,
4 Range 5 East, W.M., except the Northeast 1/4 thereof,
5 all in King County, Washington.
