

ORDINANCE NO. 4674

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$390,500 to the Jail Renovation and Construction Fund from the Current Expense Fund; amending Ordinance 4597, Sections 73 and 74, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

SECTION 1. \$390,500 is hereby appropriated from a Current Expense Fund to the Jail Renovation and Construction Fund for the initial purchase of land associated with jail construction. Interest on the loan will be paid at the current warrant interest rate as of the effective date of fund transfer.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 4597, Section 74, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Jail Renovation and Construction Fund \$390,500

SECTION 3. The project information sheet attached hereto is adopted to amend and revise the King County 1980 Capital Improvement Budget and Program, amending Ordinance 4597, Sections 73 and 74, as amended.

SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
