## ORDINANCE NO. 4676

AN ORDINANCE relating to Rules and Order of Business of the King County Council and amending Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C. 1.24.010, 1.24.080 and 1.24.090.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. ORGANIZATION. Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C.

1.24.010 are hereby amended as follows:

The Council shall elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman/
Chairman Elect for a term to begin the
first Monday of January of each even-numbered year, at which
time the Council will reconstitute itself. The Chairman and
Vice-Chairman/Chairman-Elect shall serve until the first Monday
of January, of each succeeding odd-numbered year, at which time
the Vice-Chairman/Chairman-Elect shall become Chairman and the
Chairman shall become Vice-Chairman. In the temporary absence
of the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman shall perform the duties and
responsibilities of the Chairman as imposed by this ordinance.
In the event the Chairman is unable to serve the remainder of
the term, ((a-new-Chairman-shall-be-elected-)) the Vice-Chairman
shall become Chairman. In the event the Vice-Chairman is unable
to serve the remainder of the term, a new Vice-Chairman shall be
elected.

SECTION 2. INITIAL PROCESSING - ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS.

Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C. 1.24.080 are hereby amended as follows:

Ordinances and Motions shall be drafted in conformance with drafting guidelines prepared by the Office of the Administrator-Clerk of the Council.

All official communications or requests for Council action from the Executive or Judicial Branches addressed to the Chairman shall be assigned a draft number and referred to the appropriate committee.

1	SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C. 1.24.090 are
2	hereby amended as follows:
3	INTRODUCTION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS. Upon the
4	signature of at least one member of the Council a number shall
5	be assigned to each proposed ordinance or motion. The first
6	reading of a proposed ordinance shall be by title only, unless
7	three members demand reading in full.
8	After the first reading, proposed ordinances shall be
9	referred to committee. Upon being reported back by the committee
10	all proposed ordinances shall be placed upon the calendar for
11	public hearing and second reading.
