ORDINANCE NO. 4676

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to Rules and Order  
2 of Business of the King County Council and  
3 amending Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C.  
4 1.24.010, 1.24.080 and 1.24.090.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. ORGANIZATION. Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C.  
7 1.24.010 are hereby amended as follows:

8 The Council shall elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman/  
9 Chairman Elect for a term to begin the  
10 first Monday of January of each even-numbered year, at which  
11 time the Council will reconstitute itself. The Chairman and  
12 Vice-Chairman/Chairman-Elect shall serve until the first Monday  
13 of January, of each succeeding odd-numbered year, at which time  
14 the Vice-Chairman/Chairman-Elect shall become Chairman and the  
15 Chairman shall become Vice-Chairman. In the temporary absence  
16 of the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman shall perform the duties and  
17 responsibilities of the Chairman as imposed by this ordinance.  
18 In the event the Chairman is unable to serve the remainder of  
19 the term, ~~((a new Chairman shall be elected-))~~ the Vice-Chairman  
20 shall become Chairman. In the event the Vice-Chairman is unable  
21 to serve the remainder of the term, a new Vice-Chairman shall be  
22 elected.

23 SECTION 2. INITIAL PROCESSING - ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS.  
24 Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C. 1.24.080 are hereby amended as  
25 follows:

26 Ordinances and Motions shall be drafted in conformance  
27 with drafting guidelines prepared by the Office of the Adminis-  
28 trator-Clerk of the Council.

29 All official communications or requests for Council action  
30 from the Executive or Judicial Branches addressed to the Chairman  
31 shall be assigned a draft number and referred to the appropriate  
32 committee.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1373 and K.C.C. 1.24.090 are hereby amended as follows:

INTRODUCTION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS. Upon the signature of at least one member of the Council a number shall be assigned to each proposed ordinance or motion. The first reading of a proposed ordinance shall be by title only, unless three members demand reading in full.

After the first reading, proposed ordinances shall be referred to committee. Upon being reported back by the committee, all proposed ordinances shall be placed upon the calendar for public hearing and second reading.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 31st day of December, 1979.
