AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of Peter W. Johnson, Building and Lakd Development Division File No. 145-79-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Peter W. Johnson petitioned on March 9, 1979, that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from A to G and this application was assigned Building and Land Development Division File No. 145-79-R.

SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Building and Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on May 10, 1979, and hearing was held by the Examiner on the matter May 17, 1979. 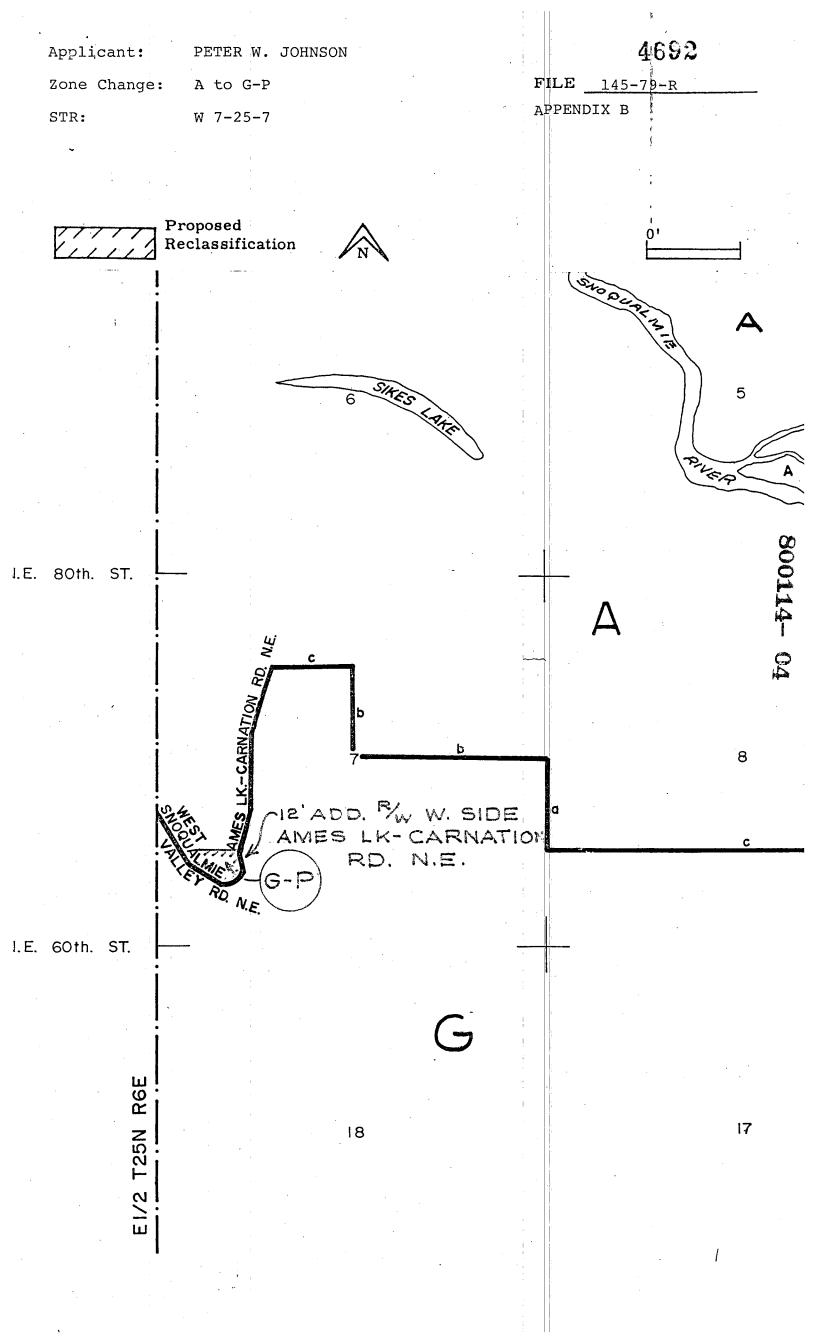

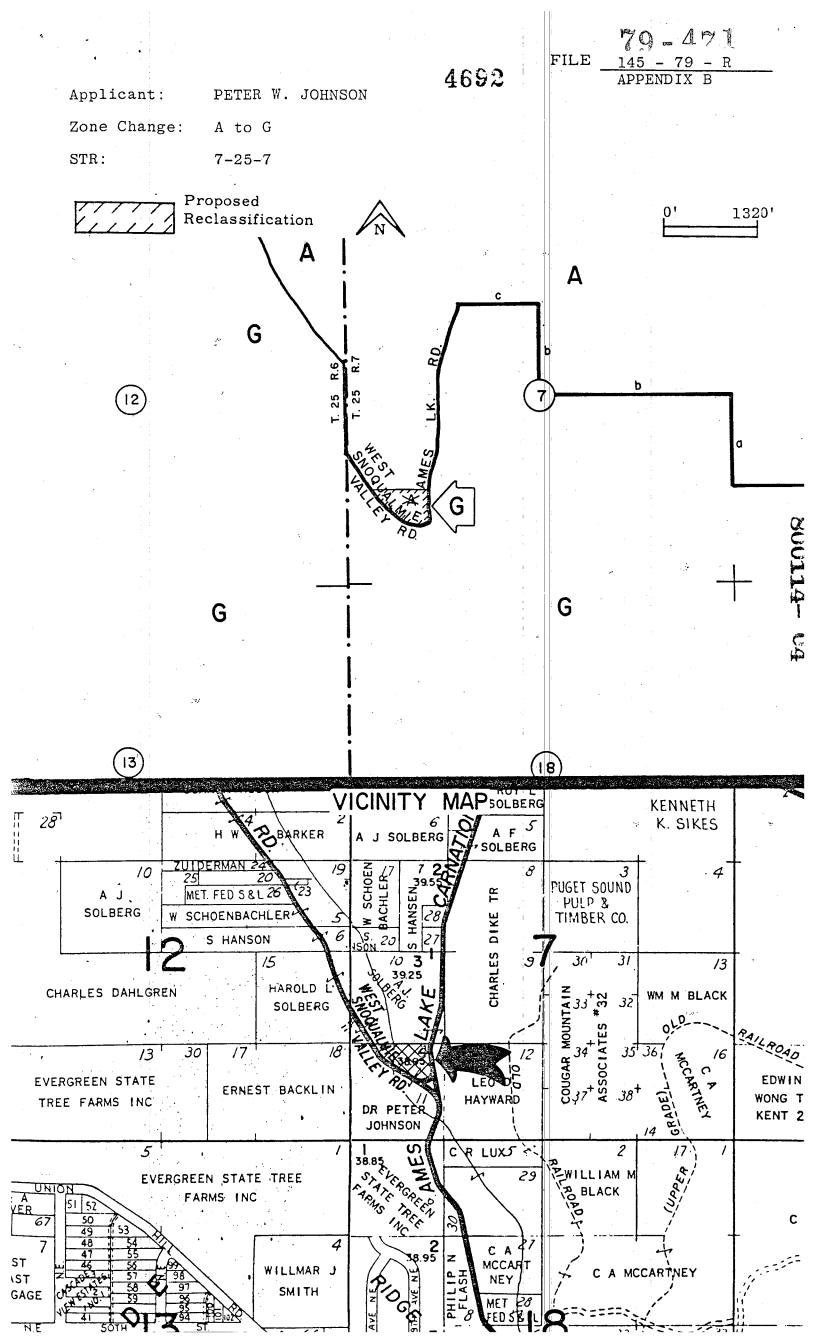
