ORDINANCE NO. 4706

AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of William M. Spencer, Building and Land Development Division File No. 167-79-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. William M. Spencer petitioned on May 1, 1979, that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from RS 7200 (potential RM 1800) to RM 1800 and this application was assigned Building and Land Development Division File No. 167-79-R.

SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Building and Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on August 9, 1979, and hearing was held by the Examiner on the matter August 9, 1979. The report of the Examiner was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on October 11, 1979, and the Council approved the reclassification by Motion No. 4554 on October 15, 1979, subject to conditions which will be satisfied per the "P" suffix.

The legal description of the property to be reclassified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the attached map which is designated Appendix B and is hereby made


