

ORDINANCE NO. 4714

AN ORDINANCE relating to storage and retrieval of King County Council permanent records, amending Ordinance 695, Section 2, and K.C.C. 2.12.020.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with provisions of R.C.W. 42.17.020, it is necessary for local government agencies to make records available. It is in the best interests of the public to make King County Council records, ordinances, motions and proceedings as easily available as possible.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 695, Section 2, and K.C.C. 2.12.020 are hereby amended as follows:

1. The responsibility for storage and retrieval of the records including the records of the King County Council has been established by the 1971 Appropriations Ordinance, and this chapter with the executive branch in the Records and Elections Division.

2. All records of the King County Council and records of the King County Commissioners, prior to the establishment of the Home Rule Charter, other than office files and memoranda shall be either photographed, microphotographed, photostated or reproduced on film by the Records and Elections Division.
