ORDINANCE NO. 4715

AN ORDINANCE relating to Department of Public Safety; constructing a Federal Way Police Substation on the Steel Lake Fire Station site; amending Ordinance No. 4597, Section 28.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 4597, Section 28, is hereby amended as follows:

PUBLIC SAFETY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Public Safety \$18,412,641

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) The Department of Public Safety and the Department of Public Works, in coordination with the County Council, shall approach the 1981 Legislative Session to amend state law so that county radio maintenance staff become members of the classified civil service without being subjected to competitive hiring procedures.
- 2) By March 1, 1980, the department, in coordination with the Auditor, shall complete a study of present and proposed Marine Patrol services in King County including: legal and contractual services which the County must perform; adequacy of present resources to meet requirements for Marine Patrol services; cost and potential revenue sources to expand the present program; and policy questions to be considered by the Council in any decision to expand the present service level.
- 3) \$79,000 shall be used to construct a Federal Way police substation on the present site of the (~~Federal-Way District-Court~~) Steel Lake Fire Station.
- 4) The Department shall increase the authorized number of police officers by 47, including two assigned to the Prosecuting Attorney's Special Operations Unit.
