ORDINANCE NO. 4739

AN ORDINANCE extending the time period for reintroduction of Zoning Ordinances and Motions as stated in Ordinance 1373, Section 15, as amended and K.C.C. 1.24.150 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. The time period for reintroductions of ordinances and motions as stipulated in Ordinance 1373, as amended, and K.C.C. 1.24.150 would end with the Council Agenda of February 11, 1980. The Council by this ordinance does hereby extend the time period for reintroduction of Zoning Ordinances and Motions to February 25, 1980.

Section 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
