AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Midvale Avenue North V-1630 Petitioner: Highland Plaza, Inc. and Others

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Midvale Avenue North, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area was obtained by quit-claim deed in 1962. The Department of Public Works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The description furnished on the petition has been revised to retain the westerly 20 feet to maintain the County's 60 foot right of way. This change was recommended by the Division of Building and Land Development and the Department of Public Works. This revision provides that adequate right of way remains if an urban trail is developed in the area at a later date.
- 6. The Department of Public Works considers the 20 feet lying easterly of the County's 60 foot right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 25th day of February, 19 80.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
