The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and reports that the vacation was recommended as a condition for final approval of the preliminary plat of Washington Park Estates (379-1). This Division would have no objection to the proposed vacation provided reasonable assurance of plat finalization is obtained.
- 4. The vacation area, containing approximately 0.449 acres, was acquired by quit claim deed dated May 8, 1978. The Department of Public Works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
