

ORDINANCE NO. 4808

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Employee Code of Ethics; disclosure of income and investments; changing the date by which required forms must be filed; amending Ordinance 1308, Section 6 and K.C.C. 3.04.050.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1308, Section 6, and K.C.C. 3.04.050 are hereby amended as follows:

Disclosure of income and investments. All persons appointed by the county executive, to include board and commission members, all persons appointed by the county administrator which are subject to the approval of the county executive all employees of the council, and such other public employees as may be determined by the board of ethics, shall file with the board of ethics within ten days of employment or appointment and on or before ~~{January-31st}~~ April 15th of each year a written statement of:

(1) All sources of income in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars per year; and

(2) The name of any corporation, firm or enterprise in which he or she has a direct financial interest in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars; provided, that policies of insurance issued to himself or herself, or spouse, accounts in banks, savings and loan associations or credit unions, are not to be considered financial interest; and

(3) Every office or directorship held by the employee, his or her spouse, or any member of his or her family in any corporation, association, firm or enterprise, both profit and nonprofit, doing business in King County; and

(4) A list by legal description or popular address of all real property owned in King County by the employee, his or her spouse, or member of the family, including options to buy if the property is valued in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars; and

(5) With respect to attorneys or others practicing before state and local regulatory agencies during the preceding twelve-month period, the name, the agency or agencies and the name of the firm, partnership or association in which the person is a member, partner or employee and the gross compensation in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars received by the attorney and the firm, partnership or association respectively for such practice before such regulatory agency; and

(6) All candidates for county elective office shall, within two weeks of becoming a candidate, as defined by R.C.W. 42.17.020, and all elected officials, paid in whole or in part county funds shall file with the board of ethics on or before ((January-31st)) April 15th, a code of ethics financial statement, which includes subsections one(1) through (5) above. ((This)) These requirements may be satisfied by filing with the board of ethics a copy of the report required to be filed by R.C.W. 42.17.240 commonly referred to as Form F-1, if this form contains an original signature of the person filing the report.

((PROVIDED, -with-the-exception-of-subsection-(6), -that statements-due-to-be-filed-no-later-than-January-31,-1975,-shall be-filed-no-later-than-February-21,-1975))
