ORDINANCE NO. 4808

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Employee Code of Ethics; disclosure of income and investments; charging the date by which required forms must be filed; amending Ordinance 1308, Section 6 and K.C.C. 3.04.050.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1308, Section 6, and K.C.C. 3.04.050 are hereby amended as follows:

Disclosure of income and investments. All persons appointed by the county executive, to include board and commission members, all persons appointed by the county administrator which are subject to the approval of the county executive all employees of the council, and such other public employees as may be determined by the board of ethics, shall file with the board of ethics within ten days of employment or appointment and on or before ((January-31st)) April 15th of each year a written statement of:

- (1) All sources of income in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars per year; and
- (2) The name of any corporation, firm or enterprise in which he or she has a direct financial interest in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars; provided, that policies of insurance issued to himself or herself, or spouse, accounts in banks, savings and loan associations or credit unions, are not to be considered financial interest; and
- (3) Every office or directorship held by the employee, his or her spouse, or any member of his or her family in any corporation, association, firm or enterprise, both profit and nonprofit, doing business in King County; and
- (4) A list by legal description or popular address of all real property owned in King County by the employee, his or her spouse, or member of the family, including options to buy if the property is valued in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars; and
