ORDINANCE NO. 4809

AN ORDINANCE relating to Per Diem; stating the amounts to be paid to members of the Personnel and Fair Boards; amending Ordinance 174 (part) and K.C.C. 3.08.110; adding a new section to Ordinance 1128 and K.C.C. 2.32.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 174 (part), and K.C.C. 3.08.110 are hereby amended as follows:

Compensation. For time devoted to the official work of the Personnel Board, each member thereof shall receive a per diem of ((thirty-five)) fifty dollars to be paid out of the current expense fund; provided that a per diem of ((twenty)) twenty-five dollars shall be paid for official board work of three hours or less.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is hereby added to Ordinance 1128 and K.C.C. 2.32 a new section to read as follows:

Compensation. For time devoted to the official work of the fair board, each member thereof shall receive a per diem of fifty dollars to be paid out of the current expense fund; provided that a per diem of twenty-five dollars shall be paid for official board work of three hours or less.
