

ORDINANCE NO. 4823

AN ORDINANCE transferring previously appropriated funds in the amount of \$27,529 to Parks and \$17,996 to Planning from Special Programs to plan for a park, recreation, and open space preservation bond program, amending Ordinance No. 4597, Sections 23, 25 and 43 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of \$27,529 from Special Programs to Parks.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 4597, Section 23 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Parks (~~(\$6,852,758)~~) \$6,880,287

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) Park Manager I positions shall be phased in pursuant to the following schedule:
 Kenmore District (April 1), Marymoor District (January 1), Wilderness District (July 1), Burbank District (April 1), Angle Lake (January 1), and Steel Lake (July 1).
- 2) Two CETA Utility Worker I positions shall be absorbed June 1 and September 1.
- 3) The Planner I position and the Cartographer position authorized to provide staff support for a proposed Parks and Open Space Bond Issue shall terminate on September 30, 1980.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of \$17,996 from Special Programs to Planning.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 25 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Planning (~~(\$1,586,274)~~) \$1,604,270

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) The Planner I position authorized to provide staff support to the Parks and Open Space Bond Issue shall terminate on September 30, 1980.

The Council intends that:

The Planning Division provide staff support to the Council for METRO and PSCOG issues as requested.

The Planning Division carry out its 1980 work program for the Snohomish/Snoqualmie Resource Management Plan.

1 SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 43 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:




