ORDINANCE NO. 4854

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "Hess" to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "Hess" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective March 15, 1980.
