STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 71st Avenue N.E., hereinafter described.
- The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities 2. serving the area and was advised that easements have been secured by Puget Sound Power and Light Company and Washington Natural Gas.
- The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The Division of Building and Land Development has determined that the property owners will have access via N.E. 128th Street and 72nd Avenue N.E.
- The vacation area is a portion of the plat of Lake Park Addition to the City of Seattle, which was recorded on July 29, 1904. The Department of Public Works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax tolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 21st day of a 1980 .

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
