- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a drainage easement in the Plat of Wildwood Estates No. 2, hereinafter described.
- The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed drainage easement vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- Subject easement was established as part of the Plat of Wildwood Estates No. 2 to provide access to a detention pond. Subsequently a residence was constructed which encroached upon the easement area, thus resulting in an encumbered title. The developer has provided a substitute access to the detention pond. The new access was approved by the County Division of Hydraulics on November 28, 1979. Therefore the original easement is no longer required.
- 5. In accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759, the vacation of the drainage easement would be classified "C Class."
- The Department of Public Works considers the subject drainage easement useless and believes the public would be benefited by its vacation. No County roads are affected by subject proposed vacation.
