

ORDINANCE NO. 4875

AN ORDINANCE relating to procedures regarding the solicitation and awarding of professional and/or technical service contracts; and amending Ordinance 2363, Sections 1, 2 and 4 and KCC 3.04.120.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2363, Sections 1, 2 and 4, and KCC 3.04.120 are amended to read as follows:

(a) It shall be the duty of any private consultant firm and/or individual entering into contracts with King County to perform studies costing in excess of two thousand five hundred dollars to file both with the King County Board of Ethics and the King County Executive a sworn written statement disclosing:

(1) Any office or directorship in the firm held by any King County employee, his or her spouse, or any member of his or her immediate family;

(2) Any financial interest held by any King County employee, his or her spouse, or any member of his or her immediate family in the firm as follows:

(A) Ownership of over five percent of the stock or other form of interest in the firm;

(B) Receipt of any amount of salary from the firm or individual;

(3) All contracts between the private consulting firm and/or individual and King County in the five years immediately preceding the presently contemplated contract including the amount of money paid by King County to the consulting firm and/or individual pursuant to the contract;

(4) Any position or positions on any King County board or commission, whether salaried or unsalaried, held by any officer or director of the firm;

(5) The private consulting firm and/or individual shall further make known to both the King County Board of Ethics and the King County Executive any other information known to it regarding any potential interest or conflict of interest other than that disclosed pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.14.010 of this code.

(b) No contract with any private consultant firm and/or individual shall be considered final until five days after receipt by the Board of Ethics of the information required to be disclosed by this section.

~~(e) -- A consultant will be prohibited from bidding on a proposed contract for which he has previously acted as a consultant.~~
