ORDINANCE NO. 4893

AN ORDINANCE establishing an 80 foot truck loading zone on the west side of 16th Avenue S.W. beginning 210 feet south of the south curb line of SW Roxbury Street for certain hours.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by KCC 46.61.575-5 adopting RCW 46.61.570-2, Schedule 20 of the King County Traffic Code which establishes freight curb loading zone along county roads is amended to add the following location:

16th Avenue SW, west side, beginning 210 feet south of the south curb line of SW Roxbury Street and extending 80 feet southerly, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday inclusive, except for public holidays.

SECTION 2: Signs to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.
