#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of S.E. 184th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. Petitioner Moe's residence was constructed many years ago in a plat which had defects in its survey. The building encroaches a few feet onto the right of way of S.E. 184th Street. Vacation of a six by twenty foot strip will clear title to the Moe property.
