STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of South 256th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The Planning Department reviewed the proposed vacation and recommended approval provided that petitioner dedicate additional right of way on 27th Place South to bring the road up to County standards.
- 5. The Department of Public Works and the Real Property Division concur with the recommendation of the Planning Department and the petitioner has furnished the necessary deed and a site plan.
- 6. The vacation area was acquired in 1967 by Quit-Claim Deed. The Department of Public Works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 7. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 1640 day of 200, 1980.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
