ORDINANCE NO. 4959

35,

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$200,000 from Retention/Detention inspection and maintenance fees and repayments to King County for reimbursable work; establishing interim financing; and amending Ordinance No. 4597, by adding a new section and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$200,000 to the Retention/Detention Facilities Management Fund.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4597, is hereby amended to add a new section to read as follows:

Retention/Detention Facilities Management Fund: \$200,000.

Provided that:

Interim funding be financed by interest bearing warrants on a tax exempt basis.

Provided further that:

The interest bearing warrants issued for interim financing shall be repaid in full by the end of 1980 by fees generated by retention/detention fees.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
