ORDINANCE NO. 4965

AN ORDINANCE relating to boating regulations; prohibiting the use or operation of internal combustion engines on Spring Lake; adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.44.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 12.44 a new section to read as follows:

Spring Lake Restriction. It is unlawful to use or operate any internal combustion engine on Spring Lake, legally defined as "All the water of Spring Lake located in Section 31, Township 23 N., Range 6 E., W.M., in King County, Washington"; PROVIDED THAT, nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any public official or construction company from performing authorized duties. The Department of Public Works shall have the responsibility of posting and maintaining appropriate signs.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 28th day of April, 1980.
