ORDINANCE NO. 4978

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 4856, and concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve M-L-P subject to conditions the application for rezone from S-R to M-L-P petitioned by LAWRENCE PSZANOWSKI, and designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 224-80-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4856 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The King County Council does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated April 2, 1980, which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on April 17, 1980, to approve subject to conditions the application for rezone from S-R to M-L-P petitioned by LAWRENCE PSZANOWSKI, and designated by the Building and Land Development Division, Department of Planning and Community Development, File No. 224-80-R, and the Council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation(s) contained in said report.
