ORDINANCE NO. 4981

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$125,000 to the County Road Construction Fund from a transfer from the County Road Fund for repairs to So. 154th Street; amending Ordinance No. 4597, Sections 73 and 74, Attachment No. 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$125,000 to the County Road Construction Fund from a transfer from the County Road Fund to provide washout repairs to South 154th Street, Capital Improvement Project No. 600780.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$125,000 from the unappropriated fund balance of the County Road Fund to "Transfer To Fund 386", Capital Improvement Project No. 999977.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 74, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the several Capital Improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified and contained in Attachment No. 1 and Section 73 of this ordinance.

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 4597 as amended, shall be fulfilled.

2 are adopted to amend and revise the 1980 Capital Improvement
3 Program and Budget; amending Ordinance No. 4597, Sections 73 and
4 74, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

5 SECTION 5. The County Council finds as a fact and declares
6 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for
7 the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or
8 for the support of county government and its existing public
9 institutions.

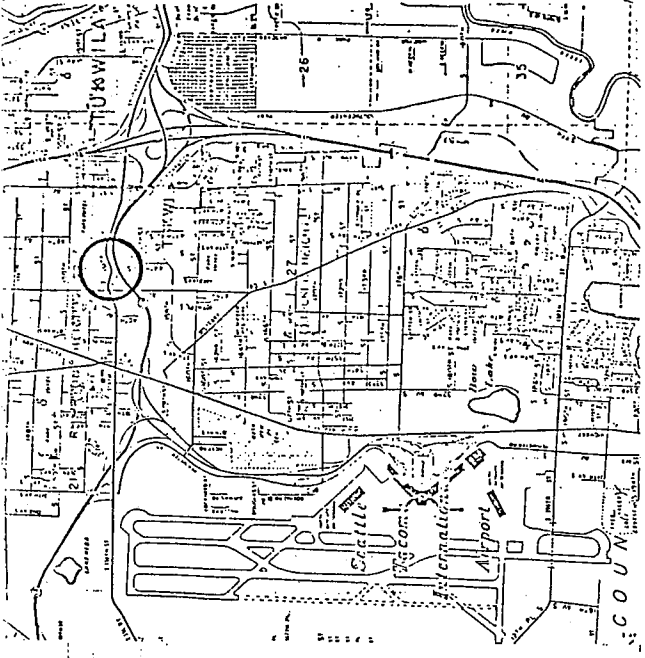
