

ORDINANCE NO. 4992

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Public Works & Transportation; removing the Equipment Rental and Revolving and Motor Pool functions from the Engineering Division; renaming the Hydraulics Division to Surface Water Management and amending the duties of said Division; amending Ordinance No. 4570, Section 1, Ordinance No. 4070, Section 6 and KCC 2.16.040, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4570, Section 1 and KCC 2.16.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Department of Public Works & Transportation'- Duties - Divisions.

(a) The Department of Public Works & Transportation shall be responsible for the administration of the Divisions of Engineering, Solid Waste, Airport, ((Hydraulics)) Surface Water Management, Administrative Services, other related utility, public works and transportation functions. The Department shall be composed of the following divisions:

(1) ENGINEERING DIVISION. The Engineering Division shall be responsible for the administration of the County roads and streets system, including road/street design, construction, maintenance programs, and the administration and operation of engineering. ((and-central-automotive functions:))

(2) AIRPORT DIVISION. The Airport Division shall be responsible for the administration of King County Airport(s), including the implementation of County policy regarding airport development, the enforcement of King County Code rules and regulations regarding airport operations, and the administration of the fiscal and operating activities of County airport(s).

(3) SOLID WASTE DIVISION. The Solid Waste Division shall be responsible for the administration of the County Solid Waste program which provides for the disposal and

2 industries.

3 ((4)) HYDRAULICS-DIVISION:--The-Hydraulics-Division
4 shall-be-responsible-for-the-administration-of-county-surface
5 water-management-programs;-including-construction-and-mainten-
6 anee-programs-which-implement-county-policy-as-it-relates-to-
7 drainage-and-the-prevention-of-floods:))

8 ((b)) A-water-and-sewer-utility-section-is-established-within
9 the-King-County-Department-of-Public-Works-&-Transportation-in
10 accordance-with-RCW-36.94.120;-the-County-Area-Services-Act.
11 Personnel-of-the-water-and-sewer-utility-section-shall-be-employed
12 in-accordance-with-provisions-of-a-personnel-merit-system-as
13 established-in-Chapter-3.12:))

14 (4) SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT DIVISION. The Surface
15 Water Management Division shall be responsible for developing
16 and/or assuming the effective implementation of policies,
17 programs and standards relating to County Surface Water
18 Management including the regulation of drainage and the
19 prevention of floods.

20 (5) ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DIVISION. The Administra-
21 tive Services Division shall be responsible for the administra-
22 tion of intradepartmental services and the coordination of
23 functions with other appropriate agencies to include
24 activities involving financial investments and budget control,
25 word processing and records retention, claims investigation
26 and complaint resolution, policy development, preparation of
27 administrative rules as required by general law, and personnel
28 services, including the administration of approved collective
29 bargaining agreements.

30 (b) A water and sewer utility section is established within
31 the King County Department of Public Works & Transportation in
32 accordance with RCW 36.94.120, the County Area Services Act.
33 Personnel of the water and sewer utility section shall be employed

1 in accordance with provisions of a personnel merit system as
2 established in Chapter 3.12.

3 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4070, Section 6 is hereby amended
4 to read as follows:

5 The Council hereby creates the Office of Fleet Administration
6 as a service agency reporting to the ((County-Road-Engineer))
7 Director of the Department of Public Works & Transportation or
8 the manager of Administrative Services if so designated by the
9 Director.
