

ORDINANCE NO. 5040

AN ORDINANCE transferring \$48,770 from Special Programs, Executive Contingency to the Boundary Review Board, amending Ordinance No. 4597, Sections 38 and 43, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Council hereby approves and adopts an appropriation of \$48,770 to the Boundary Review Board from the Executive Contingency to contract for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement of the proposed incorporation of the town of Newcastle, Washington, and pay other administrative expenses of the Federal Way, Woodinville and Newcastle Incorporation proposals.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs ~~(\$2,987,793)~~ \$2,939,023

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ~~(\$195,262)~~ \$146,492 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 4597, Section 43, as amended, shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 38, is hereby amended to read as follows:
