ORDINANCE NO. 5042

AN ORDINANCE approving the "Tongue" additions and betterments to the Water District 105 Comprehensive Plan (Resolution No. 800).

PREAMBLE:

On May 5, 1980, Water District 105 adopted Resolution No. 800 which provided for the "Roy Tongue" additions and betterments to the district's Comprehensive Water Plan.

These additions and betterments are exempt from the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act.

As required by KCC Chapter 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed these proposed additions and betterments and on May 28, 1980 recommended their approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The "Tongue" additions and betterments to the Water District 105 Comprehensive Water Plan as adopted by district Resolution No. 800 (attached) are hereby approved.
