ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the formation of a water district in the vicinity of Fall City, Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A petition for the formation of a water district in unincorporated Fall City, Washington was filed with the County Council.
- 2. The petition states that the object for the creation of said district is the "acquisition of the stock and/or assets of the Fall City Water Company, a Washington corporation, now operating a water supply system in unincorporated Fall City, Washington, and the acquisition, construction, maintenance, operation, development and regulation of a water system including water supply and distribution and water treatment plants as may be necessary and all necessary appurtenances and additions and betterments thereto in said area."

It further states that the establishment of said water district will be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare and will be of benefit to the property therein.

- 3. The Records and Elections Division has examined the signatures on the petition and has certified it to be sufficient under the provisions of R.C.W. 57.04.030.
- 4. King County filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated July 10, 1980 on the formation of proposed water district.
- 5. The County Council held a public hearing on the 4th day of August, 1980 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.04.030.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the proposed water district shall be as follows:

That portion of Section 9 except the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter and Section 10 lying southerly and westerly of the Snoqualmie River; and the south half of 2 the southwest quarter together with the south 250.00 feet of the east 250.00 feet of the north half of the 3 southwest quarter of Section 11; and the west half of Section 14; and all of Sections 15 and 16; and the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 21; and the west half togetherwith the north half of the northeast quarter of Section 22; all in Township 24 North, Range 7 East, W.M., situated in King County, Washington. SECTION 2.
