ORDINANCE NO. 5045

AN ORDINANCE approving the water general comprehensive plan for the King County Water District No. 82 as adopted by Resolution No. A426.

PREAMBLE:

In September, 1979, Ordinance No. 4492 granted interim approval to the Water District No. 82 Water Comprehensive Plan.

In September, 1979, Ordinance No. 4490 granted interim approval to the Water District #121 Water Comprehensive Plan.

In January, 1980, King County Water District No. 121 merged with Water District No. 82.

On June 9, 1980, Water District No. 82 passed Resolution No. A426 adopting a comprehensive plan for the district and submitted it to King County for approval as required by RCW 57.16.010 and Chapter 13.24 KCC.

In July, 1980, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan and, on July 16, 1980, recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 82 Water Comprehensive Plan as adopted by district Resolution No. A426 (attached) is hereby approved.
