AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of formation of a water district in the vicinity of Fall City, Washington.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Council, by Ordinance 5043, has determined that the proposed water district in the vicinity of Fall City, Washington, as hereinafter described, will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience and be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the proposed district.

SECTION 2. The King County Boundary Review Board has deemed this matter approved as of August 11, 1980.

SECTION 3. The name of the proposed water district shall be Water District 127.

SECTION 4. A special election shall be held on the 4th day of November, 1980 or at the next special election date as provided by law, within the territory of the proposed water district, as hereinafter described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within the said territory the proposition of formation of a water district and the proposition of a general tax levy for one year, in excess of the limitations provided by law, in the amount of one dollar and twenty-five cents per thousand dollars of assessed value.

SECTION 5. The boundaries of the proposed water district are hereby described as follows:

That portion of Section 9 except the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter and Section 10 lying southerly and westerly of the Snoqualmie River; and the South half of the Southwest quarter together with the South 250 feet of the East 250 feet of the North half of the Southwest quarter of Section 11; and the west half of Section 14; and all of Sections 15 and 16; and the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 21; and the West half together with the North half of the Northeast quarter of Section 22 all in Township 24 North, Range 7 East, W.M., situated in King County, Washington.

1 SECTION 6. Notice of election shall be as required by
 2 RCW 57.04.050.
