- 4. The Division of Hydraulics has approved plans of the petitioner which place storm water flows underground in the north 10 feet of the subject lots.
- 5. No public funds have been expended for acquisition or maintenance of the subject drainage easement and it is therefore classified "Class C" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 6. The Department of Public Works considers the unused portion of the subject easement useless as part of the County storm drainage system and believes the public would be benefited by the construction of housing on the unused portion of the easement and the subsequent increased lot value on the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 2nd day of September 19_80.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
