ORDINANCE NO. 5106

AN ORDINANCE establishing a CETA Youth Programs Fund; and making an appropriation of \$853,016 for CETA Youth Programs; reducing the appropriation for Youth Programs in the Grant Fund by \$1,603,000; and amending Ordinance No. 4597 by adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a CETA Youth Programs Fund.

SECTION 2. The CETA Youth Programs Fund shall be used for the deposit of CETA grant revenues for Youth Programs, intragovernmental transfers, and contributions, and for the disbursement of CETA Youth Program costs.

SECTION 3. \$853,016 is hereby appropriated from anticipated U.S. Department of Labor, CETA grants via the King Snohomish Manpower Consortium for the payment of CETA Youth Program contract expenses and other operating costs. The County Executive is authorized to enter into contracts and agreements as required to implement CETA Youth Programs from October 1, 1980.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 4597, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
