ORDINANCE NO. 5109

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$1,317,100 to the Solid Waste Capital Fund from the proceeds of a future General Obligation Solid Waste Capital Improvement Bond Sale to acquire property for the proposed Northshore Transfer Station; amending Ordinance No. 4597, Section 74, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$1,317,100 to the Solid Waste Capital Fund from the proceeds of a future General Obligation Solid Waste Capital Improvement Bond Sale in the amount of \$1,317,100 to acquire property for the proposed Northshore Transfer Station C.I.P. Project No. 003033.

SECTION 2. Whereas it is the Council's intent to authorize the sale and issuance of General Obligation Solid Waste Capital Improvement Bonds to finance the property acquisition specified in Section 1 of this ordinance and it is considered in the best interest of the County to proceed with this property acquisition in an expeditious manner, the County Executive and/or his designated representative is hereby authorized to arrange for interim financing pending the sale and issuance of the aforementioned Solid Waste Capital Improvement Bonds with the interim financing costs to be paid from the Bond Sale proceeds.
