4 ORDINANCE NO. 5112

5 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Forward
6 Thrust Arterial Resolution No. 34569
7 and the City of Medina; finding
8 certain projects to be completed and
9 adding an additional project for the
10 City of Medina.

11 PREAMBLE:

12 King County Resolution No. 34569 adopted by the
13 Board of County Commissioners on 18 December
14 1967 and approved by the voters on 13 February
15 1968 is commonly referred to as the Forward
16 Thrust Arterial Highway Improvement Bond
17 Resolution (hereinafter "Resolution").

18 Section 2 of the Resolution further provides that
19 arterial highway facilities be those public roads
20 or streets or other public ways lawfully desig-
21 nated as arterials by appropriate governmental
22 agencies. Projects described in section 3 of the
23 Resolution provide that no designated project
24 shall be limited solely to the facilities or work
25 listed and if funds are available for additional
26 arterial highway facilities they may be used
27 therefor.

28 The City of Medina by Ordinance No. 361 has
29 certified that the three Medina street projects
30 originally designated in the Forward Thrust
31 Arterial Highway Improvement Bond Resolution
32 have been completed, and further that the City
33 of Medina has in unused Forward Thrust monies.
Further, the City Council of the City of Medina
has designated 78th Place N.E. from N.E. 32nd
to Evergreen Point Road as an arterial highway
facility.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Council hereby finds the
following projects to be completed as contemplated by the
Resolution:

1. West half of 84th Street N. E. from Evergreen
Point Bridge freeway to N. E. 12th Street;

- 2. South half of N.E. 12th Street from 84th N.E. to 86th Avenue N.E.;
- 3. Lake Washington Boulevard from N.E. 10th to N.E. 12th Street, all as contemplated by section 3(r) of the aforementioned Forward Thrust Resolution.

SECTION 2. Based upon the findings of the preceding section the King County Council, pursuant to the Resolution, hereby finds that surplus Resolution bond proceeds for the City of Medina exist and that the City of Medina has designated as an arterial highway facility 78th Place N.E. from N.E. 32nd to Evergreen Point Road, and that said arterial highway facility is consistent with the purposes of the Resolution and is a County purpose and hereby specifies, ratifies and approves the expenditure of the aforementioned Resolution bond proceeds for construction of the following additional arterial highway facility:

- 1. 78th Place N.E. from N.E. 32nd to Evergreen Point Road in the City of Medina.
