ORDINANCE NO. 5113

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Forward Thrust Arterial Resolution No. 34569 and to the abandonment of certain Forward Thrust Arterial Projects within the City of North Bend and reallocating these funds to a new project.

## PREAMBLE:

King County Resolution No. 34569 adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on 18 December 1967 and approved by the voters on 13 February 1968 is commonly referred to as the Forward Thrust Arterial Highway Improvement Bond Resolution (hereinafter Resolution).

Projects described in section 3 of the Resolution provide that no designated project shall be limited solely to the facilities or work listed and if funds are available for additional arterial highway facilities, they may be used therefor. Section 2 of the Resolution further provides that arterial highway facilities be those public roads or streets or other public ways lawfully designated as arterials by appropriate governmental agencies.

Pursuant to Section 6 of the Resolution, the City of North Bend, by Ordinance No. 460 and No. 467, has certified the following Projects and facts:

- 1. Bendego Street (also known as North Bend Boulevard) from 200 feet south of Northern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to South Fork Street has been completed.
- Main Street from Park Avenue to First Street and Main Street from First Avenue to Fourth Avenue have been duly provided for as contemplated by the Resolution.
- 3. Park Avenue from Bendego Street to Main Street cannot be completed because the cost is substantially in excess of the bond proceeds allocated thereto.
- UAB-Sixth Street Project is a new public arterial highway facility within the territorial limits of North Bend.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Council finds the following projects to be completed, duly provided for and/or abandoned

because the cost of completion would be substantially in excess of the amount of bond proceeds needed to be applied thereto:

- 1. Bendego Street (also known as North Bend Boulevard) from 200 feet south of Northern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to South Fork Street.
- 2. Main Street from Park Avenue to First Street and Main Street from First Avenue to Fourth Avenue.
- 3. Park Avenue from Bendego Street to Main Street.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 6 of the Resolution, the King County Council finds the following project within the City of North Bend to be consistent with the purpose of the Resolution and County purpose and approves the expenditure of Resolution bond proceeds for construction of the following new arterial highway facility:

1. UAB - Sixth Street Project.
