

ORDINANCE NO. 5122

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Picton Annexation to King County Water District No. 111.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Picton Annexation to King County Water District No. 111 was filed with the County Council August 21, 1980.

2. King County Water District No. 111 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 151-5-80 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 111 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated July 24, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 29th day of September, 19 80, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 111 of the area known as Picton Annexation and described in Section 3 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

1 SECTION 3. The area known as Picton Annexation to be
2 annexed is described as follows:

3 That portion of the West 1/2 of Section 26, Township 22
4 North, Range 5 East, W.M., and that portion of the NE 1/4 of
5 the NE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 5 East,
6 W.M. described as follows:

7 Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 26;

8 Thence Easterly along the North line of said Section 26 to
9 the Northeast corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said
10 Section 26;

11 Thence Southerly along the East line of the said NW 1/4
12 of the NW 1/4 to the Northwest corner of the SE 1/4 of the
13 said NW 1/4 of Section 26;

14 Thence Easterly along the North line of the said SE 1/4 to
15 its intersection with the North-South centerline of said
16 Section 26;

17 Thence Southerly along said North-South centerline to the
18 South line of said Section 26;

19 Thence Westerly along said South line to the Southwest
20 corner of the East 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 26;

21 Thence Northerly along the West line of the said East 1/2
22 to its intersection with the East-West centerline of said
23 Section 26;

24 Thence Westerly along said East-West centerline to the
25 West line of said Section 26 which is also the East line of
26 said Section 27;

27 Thence Northerly along said East line to the Southeast corner
28 of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Section 27;

29 Thence Westerly along the South line of the said NE 1/4
30 of the NE 1/4 to a point which is 660 feet Easterly of the
31 Southwest corner of the East 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the said
32 NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4;

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1 Thence Northerly parallel with the West line of the said
2 East 1/2 a distance of 660 feet;

3 Thence Westerly parallel with the South line of the said
4 NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 to the West line of the East 330 feet
5 of the said NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4;

6 Thence Northerly along said West line to the North line of
7 said Section 27;

8 Thence Easterly to the Northeast corner of said Section 27
9 which is also the Northwest corner of said Section 26 and the
10 Point of Beginning.
