ORDINANCE NO. 5160

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$62,500 to the Langston Sewer ULID Construction Fund; reallocating Community Development Block Grant funds to Langston Sewer ULID; amending Ordinance No. 4597, Sections 73 and 74, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$62,500 to the Langston Sewer ULID Construction Fund from a transfer from the Community Development Block Grant fund to provide construction match for the Langston Sewer ULID, Capital Improvement Project No. 770006.

SECTION 2. Recaptured county population funds from Panorama Vista Sewers (CD-657) in the amount of \$250,000 within the Community Development Block Grant Fund are hereby reallocated to Langston Sewers (CD-852-78, 79). \$62,500 of the recaptured funds shall be for a construction subsidy, and \$187,000 will be available for lien loans for eligible homeowners.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 74, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

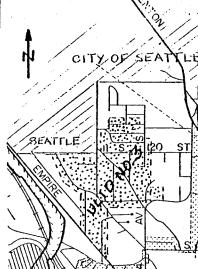

The provision of a sanitary sewage collection system in an area containing approximately 200 existing residences and approximately 400 sites which are buildable when sewers are available. The ULID No. 3 area extends from the Seattle City Limits (59th Avenue South) southerly to Empire Way. Petitions were received from the property owners in 1972, however, construction was dependent on completion of the Empire Way Interceptor, in service in February,

HUD Block Grant Funding amounting to \$125,000 is available to assist in construction costs. It is anticipated the ULID will go to a Hearing on Formation, as required by law, late in 1980. The area plan and soils study for the area has been completed. If ULID No. 3 proceeds to completion, ULID No. 4 will be formed to serve contiguous areas.
