ORDINANCE NO. 5162

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water System Comprehensive Plan for Riverbend Homesites Association, Inc.

PREAMBLE:

On July 22, 1980, Riverbend Homesites Association, Inc., passed a resolution adopting a Water System Comprehensive Plan for the area and submitted it to King County for approval as required by RCW 57.16.010 and Chapter 13.24 KCC.

In July 1980, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed Riverbend Homesites Association, Inc. Water System Comprehensive Plan and, on July 30, 1980, recommended its approval.

On September 8, 1980, King County filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the Riverbend Homesites Association, Inc. Water System Comprehensive Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Riverbend Homesites Association, Inc. Water System Comprehensive Plan, revised May 1980, as adopted by Association resolution (attached) is hereby approved.
